An argument for civic duty exercised by local communities, towards a stronger democracy. At the point of publication, Daniel Kemmis (1946 -) was Mayor of Missoula, Montana. Lucid examination of governance in the US. Kemmis argues the voting citizenry, inhabiting unique locales, by listening to concerns of other local communities inhabiting yet different places (rural, urban, plus corporations lodged in towering buildings) holds the secret. Reviewing the political development in the West, Kemmis shows hazards of living in unexplored vast stretches of alien lands, despite differing views and goals, pilgrims were keenly their inter-dependence on one another, and their commonweal became a clear primary concern. Case made for revitalization of public life through sensitivity to mutual needs, community by community. There are the national economy, global economy, and then, local economies. With importance placed on local and state power, local political participation is triggered, ultimately to the good of the country at large, not unlike the clarity of vision in the opening of the West.
